"ALABASTER" FUSED GLASS SHADES

Materials: "Alabaster" fused glass shades are made from pieces of hand-rolled glass that resembles real Alabaster and is assembled onto a flat sheet and slowly fused together into one piece of glass. This piece is then cut, sanded and returned to the kiln to be slumped into a bowl shape.

Colors: Primarily cream and off-white though no two are exactly alike. Custom colors and patterns are also available.

Shapes:	12" Bowl:	12" diameter x 3" deep	2 sockets
	18" Bowl:	18" diameter x 4" deep	3 sockets
	22" Bowl:	22" diameter x 5" deep	3 sockets
	27" Bowl:	27" diameter x 7" deep	3 sockets
	19" Deep Bowl:	19" diameter x 5" deep	3 sockets

Lamps: 100 watt A-19 or 150 watt Q150 per socket. Can be PL adapted.
